- 1. Financial Report- Treasurer Heather Hatfield gave the report and announced she took her name off the ballot for the November Election. Supervisor Dan Bonamie motioned to accept the report with the auditor's review. Supported by Doug Yanniello. All Ayes, motion carried.
- 2. Hall rental/Classes-Table to next months meeting on cleaning fee with Weyerhaeuser etc. 100 plus people.

Reports:

- 1. Zoning- Nothing to report.
- 3. Fire Department report was given by LT. Bill Morrow. In July 2022, the Beaver Creek Fire Department was busy attending to the following:
 - BCFD responded to 43 Requests for aid, with 1 request for mutual aid assistance, one to South Branch Fire.
 - July training was Water supply and hydrant use, Drivers training rodeo, and PFAS training from the State of Michigan.
 - We had eight confined space stand by with two at Weyerhaeuser and six at Georgia Pacific.
 - The military rzr side by side and Tender -1 were down for repairs. Both are back in service.
 - Congratulations to Brian Calkins and Stephanie Kinkle who are now off probation.
 - The 4th Annual BCFD Garage Sale was a great success. Thanks to everyone who participated in setting up and running it. We raised \$950.00 that the firefighters will use for new chairs.
 - Chief Bourgeois attended the Crawford County Chiefs and MABAS Meetings in July. He also attended A two-day chief's seminar in Travers City. The State Fire Marshal was there, and

- topics included: updated MIOSHA Part 74, New Firefighter Training Council's rules, Reading smoke and buildings, and SOP's and the law.
- The Beaver Creek Fire Department was chosen to take part in a PFAS program administered by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. Nine out of twelve Firefighters gave blood and completed surveys to help future Firefighters be aware about the health effects of PFAS.
