Beaver Creek Township Residents Emergency Policy

When a temperature emergency is declared, the township Supervisor, may make the township hall available, as a temporary shelter, for residents. The Supervisor will post those emergency declarations, on the Beaver Creek Township Website. The Supervisor will, to the best of his/her ability, coordinate those efforts with support personnel. (The township hall will be available to Beaver Creek residents on a first come first serve basis, unless the township Supervisor determines, a resident's health issue takes priority.)

***In the event of a declared emergency:

- * Township hall facilities may be used for temporary housing for residents during excess temperature emergencies.
- * Other area of the township building may be utilized, at the discretion of the Supervisor.
- * Residents must provide, items for their personal comfort, while utilizing the township facility.
- * If the Township has, a rental agreement in place, for the time frame of the emergency, a refund or an alternative date will be offered as compensation.
